The AIA was founded in 1987 to address specific needs of Military Personnel of Native American Descent. The association was chartered by the state of TN in October 1988; control No. 208360. The organization has been 501(c) 3 Non-profit exempt since December 1999.

The AIA works to help meet the physical and social needs of the American Indian Community in and around Shelby County TN. We will address the values, philosophy and special circumstances of America's First People to Non-Indians in a positive manner through public displays, speeches, forums and other cultural programs. The organization will continue to serve our Native American Veterans with support and social meetings.

The AIA endeavors to help preserve the American Indian Culture and Heritage by promoting and creatively sharing the American Indian's colorful and multifaceted culture with interactive activities that allow for participation from other groups, businesses and organizations.

The AIA will encourage and reward excellence by hosting and/or actively participating in Native American social events, school programs, scouting events, environmental endeavors, educational scholarship grants, benevolence activities, emergency relief programs, Veteran's assistance programs and prison programs. The AIA will address and teach the Non-Indian public through lectures, demonstrations and performances. Additionally the group will utilize the entertainment and educational venues for Native American musicians, artists and crafters.
